San Diego's Liberty Station Secures Historic Funding

C.W. Clark received \$6.2 million in New Markets Tax Credits to subsidize the preservation and renovation of five historic buildings at Liberty Station, a former Naval Training Center that is being redeveloped by the **Corky McMillin Cos.**

The five buildings totaling 160,000 square feet of space are the barracks buildings and the base mall and the North Chapel. These Liberty Station buildings are being adaptively reused as a neighborhood-serving marketplace.

The funding was realized through the collective efforts of public and private partners, including **Boorders Communities** and **Bank of America**.
